BACKGROUND

Local chlorine production ensures safe water supply in remote areas during wars, floods, earthquakes and other emergency situations. It enables to:

- Guarantee that water supplied to end users is free of pathogens
- Offer a cost efficient alternative to chlorine powder
- Provide a substitute to chlorine gas which is prohibited in armed conflict areas
